


# Holy Trinity Roman Catholic Parish

(p.18) "Smudging cleanses the eyes so that we may see; smudging cleanses our ears so that we may listen better; smudging cleanses our mind to think better; and smudging cleanses the heart to always have compassion." (p. 19) (Cultural Teachings: First Nations Protocols and Methodologies, SICC, p.18 & 19).
