itwewin Corner (*itwewin* is the Cree word which means 'the word' or 'as it is said...'). **Did you know...** Treaty 4 was negotiated on September 15, 1874, in what is now known as Fort Qu'Appelle. The parties to the agreement were the Nêhiyawak (Cree), Anishinabêk (Saulteaux), Nakota (Assiniboine) First Nations and the British Crown (Canada). Treaty 4 is celebrated annually during the week of its anniversary on the traditional lands and territory of First Nations in the Qu'Appelle Valley. The Treaty 4 Gathering concludes with a powwow which is enjoyed by non-Indigenous and Indigenous peoples who travel from near and far to join the celebration.

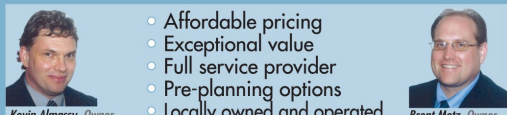
