This Nation named after Chief Standing Buffalo (Tatankanaje/Tatanka Najin) is not a signatory to Treaty 4 but are protected under the Indian Act. The Canadian government refused to recognize that the Dakota had land in Treaty 4 (https://www.cbc.ca/news/canada/saskatchewan/ottawa-rejects-claims-by-dakota-lakota-first-nations-1.669072 territory because as descendants of Chief Sitting Bull they were viewed as American refugees.
