TF #436: Living In The Psalms - Part 3





- <u>RETURN THE 'BABY ANGEL' CARD</u> to the red heart-shaped basket under the Spiritual Adoption display board in the Gathering Area to be placed on the display board.
- <u>IN OCTOBER</u> a Birth Day Shower will be held for the 'Spiritually Adopted' babies that you have been praying for. All gifts donated will go to a program to help mothers in need of assistance for new babies.
