LENT is 40 days of preparation by prayer, fasting and charitable giving, to celebrate the Paschal mystery of Easter.

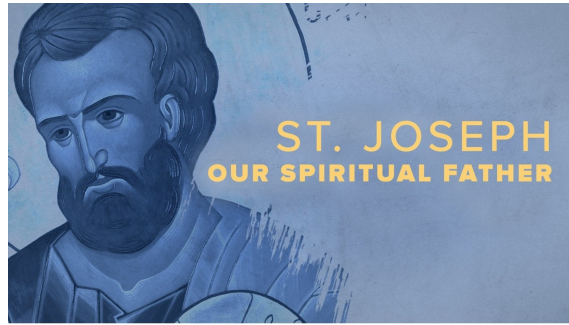

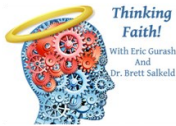

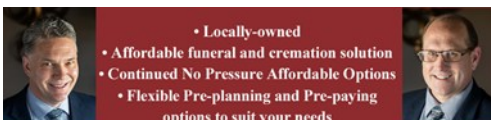
